### Assessment of Progress

**English** – Assessment will be achieved through 3 end of cycle assessments; November, March and June. Reading ages will also be assessed at these points using the Salford Reading test. Initial assessment included the McGrawhill Placement tests, Initial reading test based on KS2 questions, internal reading test and an initial assesment based on a 3 week transition SoL.

**Maths** – Assessment will be achieved through 3 end of cycle assessments; November, March and June along with a baseline test in September.
