

Year 7 Catch-Up Premium received

The Academy received **£10,373** based on the **21** students being below the expected level in English and/or Maths in 2015/16. This is the expected amount to be received for 2019/20.

Strategy and Costings

English Catchup	
Reciprocal reading strategy, guided reading, focus on vocabulary, comprehension, sounding out words and recall. Instructional reading for students with reading ages 2 years or more below expectation. Morning meeting and robust reading time used each day to provide this intervention through use of LSA's. Robust reading programme 23 minutes every day.	£5,250

Modified SoL and assessment – Numeracy focus, Math Magician (times table focus) 4 times a week in the first term. Students continue this until they reach the expected level. Set 6 continue to work on this through to the end of the year.	£5,250

Assessment of Progress

English – Assessment will be achieved through 3 end of cycle assessments; November, March and June. Reading ages will also be assessed at these points using the Salford Reading test. Initial assessment included the McGrawhill Placement tests, Initial reading test based on KS2 questions, internal reading test and an initial assessment based on a 3-week transition scheme of learning.

Maths – Assessment will be achieved through 3 end of cycle assessments; November, March and June along with a baseline test in September.
