Iceland 2026 – Important Update: Revised Dates

Dear Families,

I am writing to update you regarding the school trip to Iceland in 2026.

As you know, we have been working closely with Rayburn Tours to finalise the arrangements. During this process, we were informed that flights on the originally proposed dates of 17 – 20 October 2026 have significantly increased in cost, which would have resulted in a higher overall price for families.

To avoid passing on this additional cost and to keep the trip as affordable as possible, we have agreed revised travel dates with the tour provider. **The new trip dates will be: Friday 16 October to Monday 19 October 2026.** As students will be missing a day of school, it is their responsibility to ensure they have caught up on any work they will miss.

All plans for the trip – activities, accommodation and itinerary remain the same and the change in dates will have no impact on the overall experience for students. The only change is the slight shift in dates, which ensures the cost remains in line with what was originally communicated.

Payment Plan

Thank you to all families who have kept up with the instalment plan so far. As we move forward, I would like to remind families of the importance of making regular payments in line with the agreed instalment plan which can be found on ParentPay. This ensures the school can meet the payment deadlines set by the tour provider and that each student's place on the trip remains secure.
