Dear Parents and Carers,

Cycle 2 Mock Exams

Students are just beginning their Cycle 2 mock exams, their final rehearsal before the final examinations start in April / May, depending on subjects studied. During this period, we are supporting students prior to the exams with some booster sessions. The aim of the sessions is to increase their confidence with key knowledge and exam technique going into the exam.

Attached is the timetable for this week and next. Please note that some of the exams will finish after our normal school finishing times and particularly where students are allocated extra time. Students received a copy of this timetable the week before the February holiday, they also have their own personal exam timetable for the mock exams.

Students need to sit the exams as scheduled on the timetable as they would in the summer as exams cannot be rearranged. They need to be fully equipped for both the mock and the real exams with the correct equipment. They need a clear plastic pencil case or clear plastic wallet; two black pens, two pencils, eraser, pencil sharpener, ruler, calculator with fresh batteries for the maths, science, geography and DT exams along with any other specialist equipment.

All students were assessed in year 10 for any access arrangements needed to support them with exams such as extra time, coloured paper, use of a word processor etc. It is important that if they have an access arrangement, they show evidence of needing it. If it is not used, then it will be deemed as not needed and will therefore be taken away.

The results of the cycle 2 mock exams will be sent home week beginning 18 March along with a copy of the summer exam timetable. We will keep you up to date with other revision workshops and interventions that are organised in the lead up to these exams. If you have any queries about any of the above or would like to discuss your child's progress and strategies for this year then please contact your child's form tutor or Mr Thacker, Head of Year 11.
